- 11. Vietti Moscato D'Asti "Cascinette" 2009** **\$36.00**
Beautifully aromatic, gently sweet with a light frizzante. Tastes of grapes right off the vine. A touch of apple, apricot, citrus and flowers. Delightfully refreshing and crisp.
- 12. Little Bosco Malvasia Castelnuovo Don Bosco 2010** **\$38.00**
An enduring sweet smelling fragrance, sweet with a gentle sparkle, and is particularly suited as a dessert wine and with chocolate.

 A bright ruby red wine, intensely fruity with a lingering finish and great balance. A perfect blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

 Predominantly Sangiovese with the addition of Alicante and Malvasia Nera. Morellino is a rich velvety wine with a brilliant floral bouquet.
- 203. Terrabianca Campaccio 2007** **\$58.00**
 A blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon. Deep ruby red in color with dark fruit, mocha and roasted almond on the nose, concentrated and fresh

with perfect balance and well developed tannins.

- 204. Terre di Sole Nero d'Avola 2009** **\$38.00**
Intense aromas of violet, plums and black licorice, combined with seducing peppery tones. Full-bodied, elegant with nice silky tannins.
- 205. Villa Antinori Toscana 2007** **\$48.00**
Delicious super Tuscan blend 60% Sangiovese, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot and 5% Syrah. Intense ruby red colour, aromas of red berry fruit and oak. Complex and stylish with well-balanced silky tannins and rich in extract.
- 206. Matané Primitivo, Puglia I.G.T 2010** **\$36.00**
Very deep ruby red with violet inflections; fruity, spicy and intense bouquet, with notes of plums, cherries, rosemary and vanilla. Full, mellow, well-balanced wine showing immediate appeal.
- 207. Nebbiolo D'Alba Rocche Costamagna 2008** **\$55.00**
From the same grape that makes Barolo. A beautiful nose of violets with black cherry and spice flavors on a long, elegant finish.
- 208. Scavigna "Vigna Garrone" Calabria 2004** **\$70.00**
A powerful red from mountains of Calabria. Single vineyard selection From old vines with 18 months barrel ageing and great concentration of flavor. Produced from the local gaglioppo with cabernet franc, cabernet sauvignon and merlot.
- 209. Fay "La Faya" Valtellina IGT 2005** **\$78.00**
From a single terraced vineyard high in the Alps, a blend of 60% nebbiolo, 25% merlot and 15% syrah. Rich and complex showing the elegance of nebbiolo. Scented with a subtle aroma of spice, dark berries and plum; full and firm on the palate with generous fruit and balanced finish.
- 210. Sori' Paitin Dolcetto d' Alba Rousori 2008** **\$48.00**
A good Dolcetto with milk chocolate and berry characteristics. Medium bodied, with fresh acidity and good finish.

Intensely perfumed nose of cherries, rich and lush with a velvety texture and powerful fruit. Spicy and full bodied with great length.

A deep, rich color and a bouquet of violet potpourri, saddle leather and dried cranberries. Full of well extracted ripe raspberry and cocoa flavors with bright acid in the mouth. The wine is very well balanced. Velvety and is one of the best efforts we have seen.
- 233. Oinos Montepulciano D'Abruzzo Riserva 2008** **\$65.00**
Intense red with a strong ruby hue. Scents of blackcurrant, ripe prune and plum with 18 months refinement in French Oak. Intense and fruity with notes of coffee and chocolate. Full and elegant on the palate followed by a warm and lingering rich texture.
- 234. Canonica A Cerreto Chianti Classico D.O.C.G. 2007** **\$42.00**
Delicious classically styled Chianti, notes of herbs on nose and palate followed by hints of currant and cherry. Great length and acidity.
- 235. Cennatoio Chianti Riserva O'Leandro 2006** **\$64.00**
Intense ruby color. Blackberry notes, spicy hints of cinnamon, vanilla and cocoa. Fruity, slightly acidic with notes of tabacco.

An internationally-styled, super Tuscan blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. This wine's dense aromas of Cassis and black stone fruit are offset by notes of herbs, spice and sweet oak which carry onto a ripe palate marked by firm tannic structure.
- 327. Masseto Tenuta Dell' Ornellaia 2004** **\$430.00**
Resulting from a vintage during which Merlot ripened perfectly, the 2004 Masseto displays great aromatic complexity, with the typical prune and black cherry aromas coupled with floral overtones and subtle oak.
- 328. Cennatoio "Archibaldo Super Tuscan 2001** **\$130.00**
50% cabernet sauvignon/50% Sangiovese with 18 months in French barriques. Deep intense fruit with massive structure, fine tannins and prolonged finish.
